The Northwest District All Workers Conference Committee would like to challenge ANY Lutheran school (Preschool through Secondary) in the Northwest District to design and produce a piece of art as a center stage display for the 2012 Conference. Your school would provide us with a visual to our theme with the idea that you would then receive it back to be used as an auction item to raise money for your school, a display in your building, a gift to your church, etc. The medium and style of the art piece is for you to choose. The dimensions should be a minimum of 6 ft. and not greater than 10 ft. in width or height. The banners that have been done in previous years were in panels of 6 ft. by 6 ft.

The Northwest District will award a \$200 scholarship to the class or school whose project is chosen. The deadline for submitting your application is May 31, 2012.

The theme for the 2012 Northwest District All Workers Conference is **“Hold on Tight...Shine the Light”** and comes from Isaiah 42:6 that states "I, the Lord, have called you in righteousness; I will take hold of your hand. I will keep you and will make you to be a covenant for the people and a light for the Gentiles.
