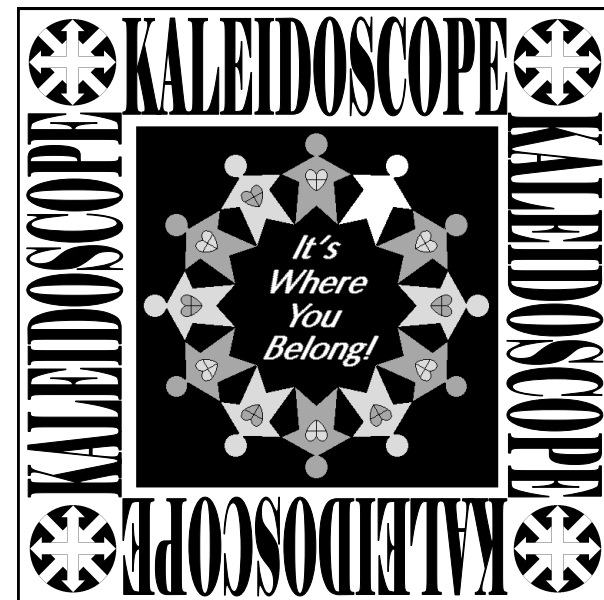
PLEASE NOTE:
