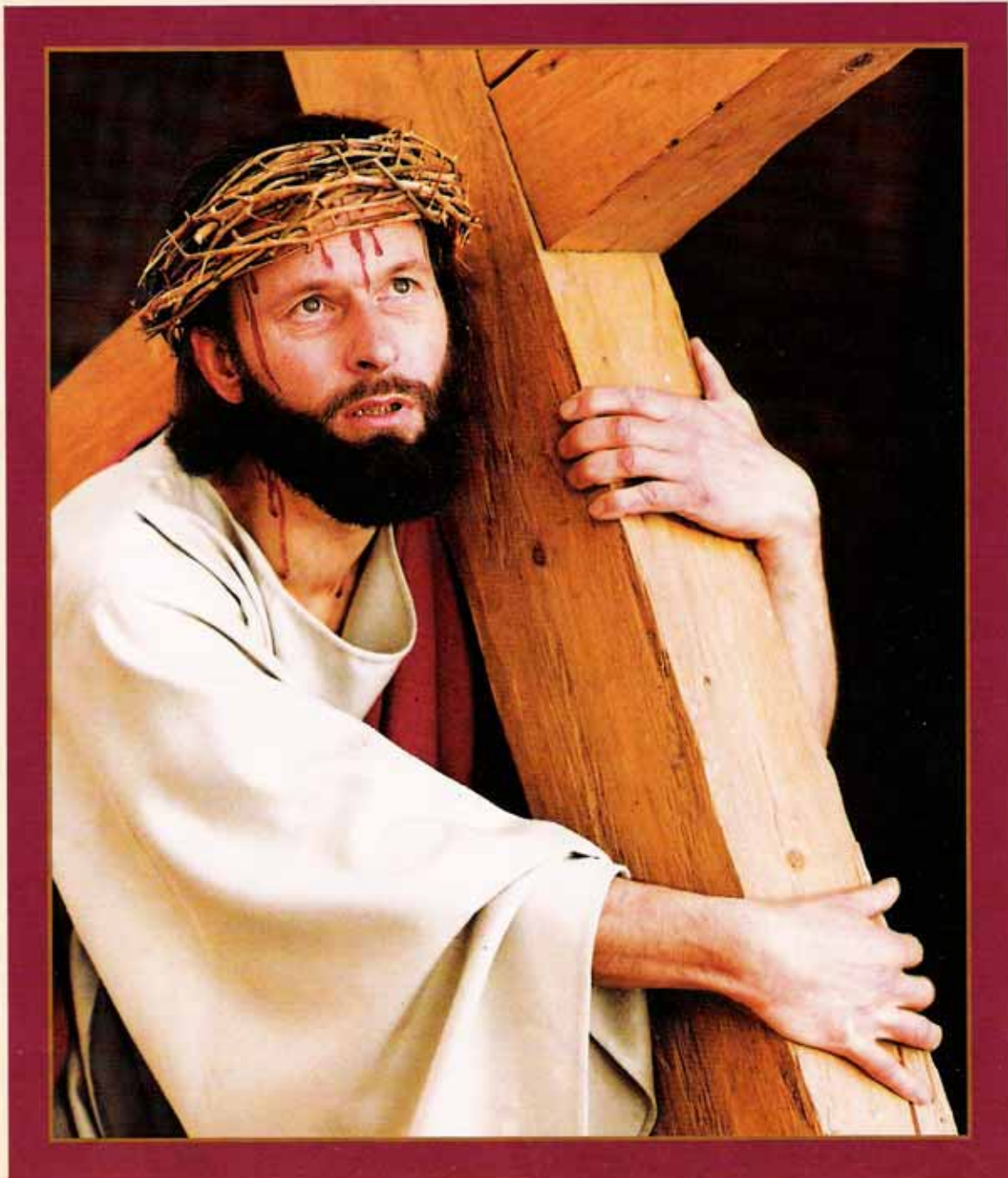

### The Passion Play Story

#### *A Promise Kept Through the Ages*

In 1633 The Black Plague swept through Europe leaving in its wake untold misery, panic and hunger. In a small village nestled amidst Germany's Bavarian Alps, the townspeople of Oberammergau made a solemn vow to God that if they were spared from this plague they would present a day-long play every 10 years depicting the last week in the life of Christ. Since the first play was performed in 1634, the villagers have kept their promise and will again present their Passion Play Masterpiece in 2010.

## YOUR DAY-TO-DAY ITINERARY

### FRI, JUL 2 – DEPART PORTLAND

Depart Portland on your overnight transatlantic flight to Rome, arriving the following day.

### SAT, JUL 3 – ARRIVE ROME

Arrive in Rome and transfer to your hotel. Located in the Region of Lazio, Rome, the "Eternal City," reflects every era. The wonders of Rome surround you. . . a world of art, history, and culture that has been attracting visitors since the beginning of Western civilization. (D)

### SUN, JUL 4 – ROME

Your sightseeing tour this morning takes you to Vatican City. See the wonderful art treasures in the Vatican Museum and Gallery and Raphael's Rooms. View Michelangelo's magnificent frescoes in the Sistine Chapel including the famous Last Judgment and The Creation of Man. This afternoon tour the remnants of "Ancient" Rome. Visit the Colosseum that once held 50,000 spectators, and see the romantic Trevi Fountain. (B)

### MON, JUL 5 – ROME/ASSISI/FLORENCE

Head north today to Assisi, birthplace of St. Francis. Highlights include the Basilica of St. Francis and the Church of St. Clair. Continue to Florence, the cradle of Renaissance Art and former stronghold of the Medici family. (B,D)

### TUE, JUL 6 – FLORENCE

Your morning sightseeing tour takes you to the Piazza della Signoria where the Neptune Fountain stands. See the Baptistery with its renowned "Gates of Paradise" doors and the Duomo. Be sure to look for Giotto's Bell Tower! The highlight is Michelangelo's original statue of David at the Academia. In your free afternoon, you may shop along the famous Ponte Vecchio or explore other Florentine delights. (B)

### WED, JUL 7 – FLORENCE/VENICE

This morning drive to romantic Venice, built on 118 small islands lying some four kilometers from the mainland. The highways are made of water and the islands are linked by numerous, picturesque bridges. With its magnificent Byzantine architecture and maze of canals with their colorful gondolas, Venice is one of the world's most glorious cities. Enjoy a walking tour beginning at St. Mark's Square, the hub of activity for Venetians and visitors alike. Highlights include the rich, Byzantine Basilica San Marco, the pink and white marble Doges Palace and the Bridge of Sighs. (B,D)

### THU, JUL 8 – VENICE/MUNICH

Travel north through the Dolomites and Austrian Alps to Munich, the capital of Bavaria. Munich was ruled for over 650 years by the Wittelsbacher dukes and kings, who left their mark on the architecture and founded the world famous Munich art collection. (B)

**FRI, JUL 9 – MUNICH/NEUSCHWANSTEIN/  
OBERAMMERGAU**

On a city tour see Marienplatz, Munich's town square, and view Nymphenburg, the former Royal Residence; Odeon Square with the beautiful Theatiner Church; and the Hall of Generals. Ascend the Bavarian Alps and view Mad King Ludwig's fairy-tale Neuschwanstein Castle, one of the most photographed palaces in the world and the model for the castles at the Walt Disney theme parks. Next visit the unusual, oval rococo Wies Church designed in the late 1740s. On to Oberammergau, site of the world famous Passion Play. (B,D)

**SAT, JUL 10 – THE PASSION PLAY OF  
OBERAMMERGAU**

The highlight of your trip! In keeping with their 377-year old promise, the villagers of Oberammergau present their Passion Play depicting the last week of the life of Christ. The play's presentation can be traced to 1633 when the Black Plague swept Europe. The people of Oberammergau took a solemn oath: if God spared them, they would present a day-long play depicting the last week in the life of Christ. To this day they have kept their promise and every ten years the citizens of Oberammergau perform their passion play with the same love and devotion they have shown for over 370 years. Today the play takes place on an open-air stage with a covered auditorium seating 4,700, against a beautiful backdrop of towering Alpine mountains. (B,L,D)

**SUN, JUL 11 – OBERAMMERGAU/LAKE LUCERNE**

Drive through the scenic Swiss Alps to Lucerne. Its attractive waterfront, 14th and 15th century covered wood bridges and medieval walls make Lucerne one of Switzerland's prettiest cities. Walk along the quaint, winding streets of the Old Town and see the 14th century wooden Kapell Bridge and the Lion Monument. Free time to stroll along the bridges, relax on the lakeshore, or visit the elegant shops. Overnight in the Lake Lucerne area. (B,D)

**MON, JUL 12 – LAKE LUCERNE**

Tour Switzerland's breathtakingly beautiful Bernese Oberland. Follow the Bruenig Pass road to Interlaken, a popular summer resort dwarfed by the famous snow-covered Alpine peaks of the Eiger and the 13,642-ft. Jungfrau. Proceed to the picturesque villages of Lauterbrunnen and Grindelwald and then return to your hotel for the night. (B,D)

**TUE, JUL 13 – LUCERNE/ZURICH/PORTLAND**

Drive to Zurich and board your return flight to Portland, arriving the same day. (B)

## A word about NAWAS . . .

**EXPERIENCE:** There is no substitute for 59 years of planning tours. Our contacts, guides, knowledge of the area, and background guarantee you the highest quality service at affordable prices.

**RELIABILITY:** In 59 years, we have won an international reputation for reliability. We deliver what we promise. And that is essential for a successful trip.

### GENERAL CONDITIONS

#### RESERVATIONS, DEPOSITS AND FINAL PAYMENT:

An initial deposit of \$600 per person is due at time of booking. Tickets to the Passion Play are limited and available on a first come, first served basis. A second deposit of \$1400 is due by August 31, 2009. (Total deposit required by 8/31/09 is \$2000). The balance of payment is due at Nawas Travel 135 days prior to departure date. Your deposit payment shall be deemed to be an acceptance of all the terms of our General Conditions.

Nawas accepts Visa, Mastercard and American Express for balance/final payments only. Credit cards are not accepted for deposits. The price of the tour already includes a built-in discount of 3% for payments made by cash or check. There is no discount on credit card sales. Credit cards will only be accepted prior to the final payment due date. Credit card charges cannot be accepted over the telephone. Tour members who want to use a credit card should contact Nawas at the time final payment is due for further information.

**TRAVEL DOCUMENTS:** A U.S.A. passport valid for 6 months after date of re-entry into the U.S.A. is required. (Non U.S.A. citizens may require visas in addition to a valid passport.) It is the responsibility of each passenger to check with the respective consulate(s) of the countries to be visited or a visa agency to determine whether they have the proper visa/travel documents for their tour.

#### THE TOUR PRICE INCLUDES:

**AIR TRANSPORTATION:** By any IATAN/ARC or other scheduled jet carrier, in economy class, based on non-refundable bulk group fares. Cancellations made after air tickets have been issued are subject to full cancellation penalties as imposed by the airlines. We strongly recommend all tour members retain both their ticket receipts and boarding passes as copies of same cannot be provided. Airline tickets must bear your first and last name as it appears on your passport.

**SURFACE TRANSPORTATION:** By deluxe motorcoach.

**HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS:** Except in Oberammergau, accommodations are at first class and select hotels based on two persons sharing a twin or double bedded room with private bath. As is the custom while attending the Passion Play, accommodations will be in private homes, pensions, inns and guest houses in and around the village of Oberammergau. Nawas cannot guarantee roommates. A person taking a single room (subject to availability) must pay a supplement of \$800. Single rooms are not available in Oberammergau.

**MEALS:** Continental breakfast and 7 dinners plus lunch in Oberammergau.

**SIGHTSEEING:** As specified in the itinerary using motorcoach transportation or other conveyances as required. Entrance fees and the services of local English-speaking guides or tour managers are included.

**TRANSFERS:** Assistance and transfers from airports to hotels and vice versa in private motorcoach.

**SERVICE CHARGES, TAXES AND PORTERAGE:** Service charges and taxes normally included in bills, government taxes on hotel bills in effect on November 14, 2008, taxes on sightseeing and excursion trips and portage at hotels of one normal size suitcase (maximum weight 50 lbs.) are included in the tour price. Porterage is not available in Oberammergau.

**FLIGHT INSURANCE:** Automatic one hundred thousand dollars flight insurance policy for each Nawas-ticketed passenger, subject to policy terms and limitations.

**DEVIATIONS:** All deviation requests from the group itinerary must be received at Nawas in writing no later than 150 days prior to departure. A \$100 non refundable fee per person will be charged on all deviations in addition to any extra airfare that may be incurred. Air deviations are subject to availability and restrictions as imposed by the airlines.

**BAGGAGE:** Allowed free of charge to your first overseas destination and from most points of return to the U.S.A.: a maximum of one bag per person (weighing 50 pounds or less) with a combined length, width and height of 62 inches plus one Carry-on Bag with total dimensions of 45 inches (approximately 22" x 14" x 9") which fits in an overhead bin or underneath the seat in front of you. Beyond the first overseas stopover point free weight allowances range from 33 lbs to 50 lbs. Excess baggage will be charged at the established rates. Airline policies regarding baggage are subject to change at any time without prior notice. It is the responsibility of each passenger to check with their airline directly prior to departure for baggage information, regulations and compliance. Nawas is not responsible for additional fees imposed by air carriers regarding baggage. Nawas Travel accepts no responsibility for loss or damage to the tour members' baggage or personal belongings at any time. Wheeled carry-on bags are not permitted due to limited motorcoach capacity. Baggage insurance is recommended and is available upon written request.

**TRAVELERS REQUIRING SPECIAL ASSISTANCE:** Disabled travelers requiring special attention or care must advise NAWAS in writing at the time of reservation. A physically able companion must accompany any person who needs special assistance. Tour directors, guides, drivers or other tour, hotel or ship personnel are not able to provide such assistance. NAWAS is not responsible for any denial of services to the disabled participant by air carriers, cruise ships, hotels, restaurants or other independent suppliers. Certain countries/destinations involve extensive walking. Be aware that outside the U.S. the Americans with Disabilities Act is not applicable and facilities for disabled individuals are limited. NAWAS is not responsible for any passenger requiring special medical equipment.

#### THE TOUR PRICE DOES NOT INCLUDE:

U.S. departure taxes, overseas airport taxes, overseas local government taxes, airline security fees/surcharges and fuel surcharges (taxes/surcharges estimated at \$300 to \$400 per person), passport fees, visa fees (if any), phone calls, valet/laundry service, wines, liquors, mineral water, after dinner coffee or tea, tips to escort, guides, drivers and waiters, sightseeing and other services not specifically mentioned, excess baggage and all other items of a purely personal nature.

**CANCELLATIONS:** Written cancellations received by Nawas Travel by August 31, 2009 are subject to a \$600 cancellation fee. For written cancellations received by Nawas from September 1, 2009 up to 135 days before the departure date, a \$1500 per person cancellation fee will be assessed. From 134 to 100 days prior to departure date, written cancellations received by Nawas are subject to a cancellation fee of 50% of the total tour price per person. Written cancellations received by Nawas between 99 and 65 days before departure date are subject to a cancellation fee of 75% of the total tour price. Written cancellations received by Nawas 64 days or less from the departure date are subject to a 100% cancellation fee of the total tour price per person. Failure to receive additional deposits and final payment by the due dates may result in the cancellation of your reservation and the forfeiture of your deposits.

Airline tickets are not refundable once issued. Nawas will issue airline tickets at its sole discretion approximately 120 days before departure. No refunds will be given for any unused services while on tour.

**We strongly recommend the purchase of trip cancellation insurance to allow for unexpected medical emergencies. Trip cancellation insurance is available upon written request.**

**IMPORTANT NOTICE:** The airfare used is based on estimated non-refundable bulk group fares projected for 2010. Airlines reserve the right to increase fares without prior notice. Tour members will be required to pay any airfare increases and fuel surcharges as imposed by the airlines prior to departure. Airlines require a minimum of 10 persons departing from the same gateway city.

Land costs and airfares are based on estimated year 2010 tariffs, and rates of exchange and overseas government taxes in effect on November 14, 2008 and a minimum of 36 or more participants. While we have made the best possible estimates of what we expect costs to be in the year 2010, we cannot guarantee actual prices, exchange rates and airfares. Any increases in land costs or airfare that may occur will be collected from each passenger prior to departure. We reserve the right to increase the cost of the tour consistent with normal increases should the group fall below 36 persons, or in the event of fluctuations in exchange rates.

Travel in the year 2010 is expected to be at an all-time high. NAWAS will make every effort to adhere to the itinerary and scheduled departure as outlined herein; however, actual group size, Passion Play ticket availability or circumstances beyond our control may necessitate alterations. Departure date, itinerary sequence and cities for overnight accommodations may change.

Please note that healthcare/medical costs outside the U.S.A. are not covered by Medicare and many private medical insurance plans. Please consult with your health insurance supplier to obtain the necessary health/medical coverage for overseas travel.
